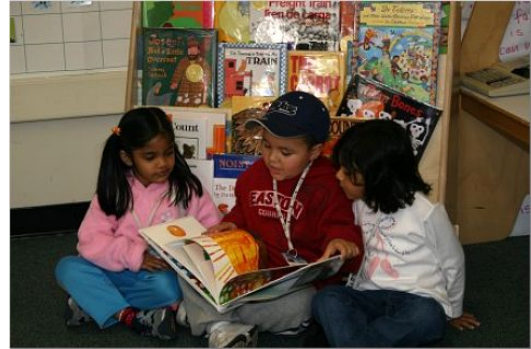

## BMAB Central Valley Fast Facts

Since 2006, Bring Me A Book Central Valley has been serving a variety of preschools that serve low-income families, including; state-funded programs, Family Resource and Referral Center, homeless shelters, Head Start, Child Abuse Prevention programs and many others. To date, Bring Me A Book Central Valley has delivered:

- 124 Bookcase Libraries
- 46 First Teachers Workshops
- 2,450 children impacted through the Bookcase Library
- 642 parents & caregivers impacted through First Teachers
- 4,120 books provided throughout San Joaquin and Stanislaus Counties



## What's New in Central Valley!

Bring Me A Book received a "Spirit of Literacy" Award from A+ San Joaquin in the category of the "Outstanding Bookcase Library".

BMAB Regional Manager Bob Morrow, along with several other agencies, has worked closely with Mayor Ann Johnston to develop a Mayor's Book Club Program entitled "Read to Me, Stockton!" The program is affiliated with the Dolly Parton Foundation, which provides a book monthly to every child aged 0-5 in a high poverty area, building a library of up to 60 books prior to entering kindergarten.
